

Nearly 1 in 3 seriously considered suicide²



DEFINING THE NEED FOR CHANGE

APAF Mental Health Awareness & Perception Study

50%

of people report having experienced a mental health issue

68%

of people believe there is marginalization associated with mental health in the U.S.

44%

of people don't believe mental health care is effective

60% of people feel that getting in to see a mental health professional

is not straightforward

Half of the US population has experienced a mental health issue, and a third are still suffering without treatment.

Most people believe there is discrimination attached to mental health care.

Skepticism about the effectiveness of mental health care remains an issue for nearly half the population.

It's still unclear to many where and how to access mental health services.

MODERN MEDICINE IN THE AGE OF GOLIATH - AI (CONT.)

- The average debt is more than \$250,000 in debt
- Too much time on EHRs about two hours on paperwork for every one hour we spend with patients.
- International Medical Graduates or IMGs such as immigration and green-card delays—to practice medicine in the U.S.

Item 4E. Today during my work, I felt emotionally drained.

Item 5D. Today over time, I could become disconnected from this type of work.

Item 6D. Sometimes I felt sickened by my today work tasks.

Item 7E. Today after my work, I felt worn out and weary.

Item 8E. Today I felt tired before I arrived at work
