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Overview

Finally, we also grappled with our status as ground zero for a social uprising watching Minnesota become more well known for division and unrest than home of several Fortune 500 companies, 10,000 lakes, theater, and innovate health care.

We are convening the community of physicians, professionals,

and neighbors to rebuild, restructure, and reimagine the Minnesota mental health system. We intend to discuss mental health access and treatment in the context of external factors such as housing, legal barriers, education, and media. These factors known as the social determinants of health will be integrated into every discussion just as our patient's health is amalgamation of all of these factors. To achieve this goal, members of the Program Committee designed an educational program focused on building a strong mental health community based on collaboration with each other, stakeholders, and advocates.
