APA Membership

The APA has several membership categories based on career level. APA and its local District Branches have a dual membership requirement.

General Members

Practicing psychiatrists who have completed an acceptable residency training program in psychiatry, and hold either a valid license to practice medicine or an academic, research, or governmental position that does not require licensure

Early Career Psychiatrists

General Members who are within their first seven years after completion of training (ACGME accredited residency/fellowship)

Resident-Fellows

Physicians who have been accepted into a psychiatric residency training program that is approved by the ACGME, RCPS(C), or AOA and remain enrolled therein

International

Psychiatrists residing outside the United States and Canada

International Resident-Fellows

Physicians who have been accepted into a psychiatric training program outside of the United States and Canada

Medical Students

Students enrolled in a school of medicine, in the United States or internationally, including osteopathic medicine

Semi-Retired and Retired

A general or life member who is near retirement age and works less than 15 hours per week in any administrative or clinical role or has reached retirement age and is fully retired from all administrative or clinical responsibilities
